For the first time, the company is looking to expand its proven formula beyond its traditional West Los Angeles core to the San Fernando Valley, Orange County and even Las Vegas. While an expansion plan has yet to be finalized, the Fish Grill management team is considering a number of new-store possibilities.

“Some might think it crazy to consider expansion at a time like this – but our customers appreciate the honest value we provide now more than ever,” explained Aharon Klein, the backyard barbecue aficionado who founded Fish Grill on the simple premise that people will come back for the freshest mesquite-grilled seafood, served fast-food style. “It’s especially gratifying that folks outside L.A. are recognizing our 23 years of hard work to make Fish Grill a local success.”

Following the success of the Beverly Blvd. restaurant, Klein opened Fish Grills on Pico Blvd. in Beverly Hill, on Wilshire Blvd. in Los Angeles, and on Pacific Coast Highway in Malibu. The Beverly Hills store features an updated version of the fishing motif of the original, while the Malibu restaurant pays homage to famous Malibu surfers from the past.

According to Klein, the Brentwood store gave him and his team the chance to plan for the future. Specifically, since it was the first Fish Grill to be located in a retail center, he saw it as an opportunity to create a prototype design that could be used for future Fish Grill restaurants.

“We consulted with a Hollywood set designer who approached Fish Grill Brentwood as if it was a movie set with a real story to tell,” he explained. “The result was a more spacious look and feel that combines the authenticity and rich fishing lore of the original Fish Grill with a bold design that will work anywhere. Despite being only three years old, the Brentwood restaurant feels like the type of place that John Steinbeck might frequent before heading back out to sea.”

“In the end, we want our customers to love seafood as much as we do, so we’re surrounding them with authentic sights and sounds to compliment the authentic tastes – whether they’re joining us in Southern California or on the Las Vegas Strip.”
